**Re:** Legislative Update

#### This Week At The Capitol:

Things have begun to slowly pick up at the Capitol. Bills are coming out like there's no tomorrow! I can't remember any time in the past when there have been 74 pages of bills in one day...anywhere from 5 to 10 per page! And, as you have seen, I've been sending them to you on nearly a daily basis. Some include youth suicide prevention; MANY include theft of automobiles by youth.

In fact, the Children's Committee will be holding their first public hearing on February 4<sup>th</sup> and two of the bills of interest for YSBs will be heard:

- 1. HB 6111, AA Establishing A Youth Suicide Prevention Program, and;
- 2. HB 6112, AA Requiring A Survey of Court-Involved Youths

I have also received some insight into how the Appropriations Budget hearings will go. Hearings will begin late in the week of February 15<sup>th</sup> (state holiday) and run through late February/early March. The last three hearings will be Education, Health and Human Services (which I believe is what DCF falls under). The good news is that Health and Human Service hearings will begin at 10 a.m. on the days they fall on and will run for as long as it takes to hear every single person who signs up. It is VERY important for YSBs to have youth they serve testify on your behalf. (We can talk about the specifics as we get closer.)

I have reached out, again, to Appropriations staff for a meeting with the Chairs. I have yet to hear back from them but will keep you in the loop.
