**Re:** Legislative Update

#### This Week at The Capitol:

YSBs were front and center this week as CYSA Advocacy Committee members and I met with the Chairs of the Appropriations Committee to go over our Legislative Agenda as it pertains to the YSB budget. The Chairs clearly understand and support YSBs and their goals! We laid out why it was important for the Committee to consider the importance of new funding for YSBs should the JJPOC recommendations pass and become law. The one thing that the Chairs noted was how imperative it is to give them data so they can point to it to make their arguments for new funding. We explained that we continue to submit RBA data to DCF, however, the Chairs would like even more. We informed them that CYSA is working on this. All in all, it was a positive and productive meeting!

As can only happen during a pandemic, the Governor released his FY 2022 and FY 2023 budget via a recorded message instead of in the House Chamber before a packed joint session of the Legislature. I have sent the budget bills to CYSA Advocacy Committee and let them know that BOTH YSB line items, the main grant and the enhancement grant, remain whole!! NO cuts by the Governor. The JRB line item increased slightly.

The next steps in the budget process are for the Appropriations subcommittees to begin a line-by-line review of their sections of the budget. In the case of YSBs, this means that the Human Services subcommittee will begin that work on February 24<sup>th</sup>, when the Commissioner of DCF appears before the subcommittee to go through her budget. March 3<sup>rd</sup> has been designated the day for the public to speak on the Human Services budget beginning at 10:00a.m. I have informed the Board how to go about registering for the hearing, however, I am happy to help anyone wishing to testify. It is, however, VERY important that I know who from CYSA will be testifying.
