Re: Legislative Update

This Week at the Capitol:

As we head towards March, budget hearings are in full swing. And...as a reminder, on Wednesday, March 3rd at 10:00 a.m. the Human Services subcommittee of the Appropriations Committee will be meeting for their hearing on the DCF budget. This means you have just a few days to register to testify and line up your kids who should also be testifying on your behalf. Please remember, the deadline for registering is Tuesday, March 2nd at 3:00 p.m. and written testimony needs to be emailed to: APPTestimony@cga.ct.gov

On Thursday, the Children's Committee met to vote on several bills including some of interest to YSBs. I have already sent you the substitute language from the three bills that passed. Those bills are:

- 1. HB 6111, AA Establishing A Youth Suicide Prevention Program (JFS to the Floor, LCO# 4029)
- 2. HB 6112, AA Requiring A Survey of Court Involved Youth (JFS to the Floor, LCO# 3727)
- 3. HB 6399, AAC The Centers For Disease Control and Prevention Youth Risk Behavior Survey (JFS to the Floor, LCO# 3833)

As I write this on Friday, the Judiciary Committee has begun hearing testimony on the Governor's comprehensive Marijuana Bill. On behalf of CYSA, Scott Cochran submitted written testimony on the bill. Other Committees including General Law, Public Health and Finance will also be hearing bills on this important issue.
