
CLINICAL SERVICES

- 169 CT towns, there are 103 YSBs serving 137 towns
- Variety of clinical services
- What are those:
 - Sliding scale – what the person can pay, regardless of income
 - Sliding scale – based on income
 - Third party billing – Husky, commercial insurances
 - Contract out
- Size of clinical services: depends on the size of your YSB. Can range from 1 person providing clinical services to bigger clinics.
- School based clinicians
- Use of social work/professional counseling interns
- Use of fee-for-service contractors
- Billing software vs using a billing service
- Growing your clinical services

OHIO SCALES

- The Ohio Scales Screening Tool is now required for JRB referrals, Truancy/Defiance of School Rules referrals and Mental Health Specific referrals. Use of the Tool for ALL TIER 2 (Individual Records) is required as of July, 2019. There are 3 versions of the tool, the Parent version, the Youth version and the Worker version, in English and Spanish.
 - Completion of the Intake Form is required for all Tier 2 youth filling out the Ohio Scales Screening Tool (JRB referrals, Truancy/Defiance referrals and Mental Health specific referrals).
 - The Intake and Ohio Scales are intended to be used together, during the first visit, to build a relationship with the youth and family and to gather necessary information.
