

# WHAT IS RISK BASED CASE HANDLING (RBCH)?

- Risk Based Case Handling is a newly adapted way of assessing cases that have been referred to the Juvenile Courts in Connecticut.
- Cases will be screened by a 10 item validated risk screening instrument Prospective Risk Evaluation for Delinquency in Connecticut (PrediCT-S).
- Results from the PrediCT-S will be used to determine case handling (diversion, non-judicial, or judicial).



## WHEN DID THIS CHANGE OCCUR?

Practice Book changes went into effect January 1, 2023.






### WHAT IS THE RBCH PROCESS?

- Police Departments are asked to electronically file summons to their assigned Clerk's Office email inbox within two (2) days of arrest
- All cases will be screened with the PrediCT-S, except those with the following exclusionary criteria:
  - Client currently on probation or with a pending judicial case
  - Client charged with a Serious Juvenile Offense or a violent felony
- Cases will be handled based on the results of the PrediCT-S, which assess the client's risk level.



### WHAT IS THE RBCH IMPACT?



- Cases are handled based on risk
- Lower risk youth will be referred to the community for support
- ➤ Higher risk youth will be provided support that is based on need from Juvenile Court
